### **Conditions of Play**

1. A minimum of 12 points is required based on 2019 Gradings. All Women shall have a rating of 4 and all ungraded men in 2019 a rating of 6 for this tournament
2. Three games of 14 ends shall be played throughout the day (two in the morning & one in the afternoon). A match must be completed in 90 minutes or the scores stand at that point.
3. No roll-ups for any match. First match commences at 9am.
4. The Asquith Men's & Ladies Bowling Club reserves the right to bring the Tournament to a satisfactory conclusion including inclement weather as it sees fit.
5. There will be no dead-ends. If the jack goes out of bounds, it shall be re-spotted by the non-offending team as close to the 2-metre mark as possible on the centre line.
6. The winning team shall be the team with the most points scored on the day.  
2 points shall be awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 for a loss. In the case of points being tied, the highest margin, and then the ends won shall be used to decide the highest placed team. If still tied, the teams involved, shall share the prize-money for those positions.
7. Composite teams may be formed from different clubs but must reach the 12 points required.
8. All players must wear their club uniform on the day.
