

Dear Valued Members,

We take the Coronavirus COVID-19 threat seriously and for the safety of our staff and members have taken extra measures to ensure your safety whilst visiting our club.

- instituting frequent sanitisation of “high touch areas” including bathrooms, door handles, buttons, tables and handrails.
